

ASAM Criteria Course For Providers

- Who Should Take the Course? <u>This Course</u> was created for anyone on the care team directly involved with assessment and placement using the ASAM Criteria. They could have varying degrees of understanding of the Criteria from beginner to advanced.
- Why Should They Take the Course? Participants will walk out of the course with a holistic understanding of using the ASAM Criteria treatment planning, patient admission, continuing care, and transfer/discharge for individuals with substance use disorder.
- What Formats are the Course Available in? The 8-Hour training is available Live-Virtual and On-Demand. ASAM hosts a monthly Live-Virtual Criteria course the 3rd Friday of every month or ASAM can work with an organization to host their own training. Learners will have the opportunity to ask the presenter questions in real time, participate in polling questions and break into small groups on a variety of real-world case based activities. The On-Demand course is fully online and self-paced. The course content, learning activities, and assessments in the course should be completed asynchronously—you will log into the course site and complete them at your own pace. The course will take approximately 8-10 hours to complete.
